### Numbers '08

Have you heard of spreadsheets but been intimidated? This class will cover the basics of what a spreadsheet is and how or why it may be the best tool for certain tasks such as organizing lists, creating graphs or just maintaining tables. Using Numbers from iWork 08, the first hour will cover absolute basics: what a spreadsheet is and how to enter text, values or formulas into tables. The second hour will cover working with data in a table, including basic formulas, graphs and charts. The third hour will look at how Numbers is different from other spreadsheets such as Excel, ClarisWorks or AppleWorks, and how these differences can help you use spreadsheets in new or different ways. Please have a copy of iWork 08 with Numbers (or a trial version) installed and working on your computer before arriving at Mac Camp or class. Expired trial versions will not work.
